TRAVEL

Air travelers have the option of flying to San Francisco or Oakland International Airports (the Oakland Airport is closer). Transportation to Berkeley from the airports includes BART (<http://www.bart.gov/guide/airport/airport.asp>), taxi, car rentals, and airport shuttles such as the BayPorter Express (<http://www.bayporter.com>). Allow plenty of time for heavy traffic and bring cash for bridge tolls (toll is \$4.00 for the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge).

PARKING

Street parking in the neighborhood of the First Congregational Church of Berkeley is very difficult. The closest garage is the Telegraph/Channing Garage (formerly called Sather Gate Garage -- <http://www.ci.berkeley.ca.us/transportation/Parking/OffStreet.html>). Overnight parking is not allowed in this garage. Also see the Parking Map link on the church's website (<http://www.fccb.org/maps.php>). The "Pay Lot" (shown as P) between Durant and Channing is the Telegraph/Channing Garage mentioned above.

DINING

Berkeley is renowned for its eateries, which run the gamut of styles, cuisines, and prices. The near-campus neighborhood where the church is located (South Side) has many inexpensive cafes and restaurants, especially on and around Telegraph Avenue (one block east of the church).
